CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Class One: \$100 Nedra Diskant Memorial Hunter

Entry fee: \$50.00

This class is open to Foxfield Medal Finalists only. Fences and course to simulate those to be used in the Medal Finals. Fence height 3'3". One horse only per finalist. Trophy and ribbons to tenth. Money to sixth place with \$10 add back.

Class Two: Foxfield Medal Finals

A (~32 and over) or B (18 to ~31)

Entry fee: \$150.00

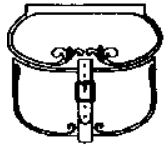
To be judged on equitation over a course of 3'3" fences. All riders will ride two rounds. Awards will be given to the top ten from each age group. Following that, the top ten **overall** will work off and compete for the Grand Championship. The scores from the first two rounds will be considered when judging the work-off and deciding the final results. The winner of the Grand Championship is ineligible to participate in any future Foxfield Medal Class. Perpetual trophy, silver trophy and monogrammed dress sheet to first; monogrammed dress sheet to second. Awards to tenth.

\$1,500 Junior and Amateur Jumping Derby

Entry fee: \$150.00

The first round and first jump-off, if any, will be decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed to complete the course. Ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time.

Scoring: Table II Section 2(a)
Time First Jump-Off

To be shown over a course of fences 3'6" in height with spreads of 3'6" to 4'0" (excluding any water obstacle). Level 3. Riders must ride for awards or prize money will be forfeited.

Weight: No restrictions
Equipment: ASTM/SEI approved hard hat with harness
Dress: Black, dark blue or scarlet coats are required
Prizes: Saddle, Calabasas Saddlery Challenge Trophy and Monogrammed Dress Sheet to winner
Ribbons through 10th place
Prize money divided as follows: 1st - \$450; 2nd - \$270;
3rd - \$210; 4th - \$165; 5th - \$135; 6th - \$105; 7th - \$90;
8th - \$75

Ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time.

Scoring: Table II Section 2(a)
Time First Jump-Off

To be shown over a course of fences 3'9" in height with spreads of 3'9" to 4'3" (excluding any water obstacle). Level 4. Riders must ride for awards or prize money will be forfeited.

Weight: No restrictions
Equipment: ASTM/SEI approved hard hat with harness
Dress: Black, dark blue or scarlet coats are required
Prizes: Trophy and Monogrammed Dress Sheet to winner
Ribbons to 10th place
Prize money divided as follows:
1st - \$1,500; 2nd - \$900; 3rd - \$700; 4th - \$550; 5th - \$450;
6th - \$350; 7th - \$300; 8th - \$249

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
2. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**
3. The Foxfield Jumping Derby reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the Foxfield Jumping Derby without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question covered in the rules shall be decided by the Foxfield Jumping Derby, their decision to be final.
4. Foxfield reserves the right to itself to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages.
5. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the Foxfield Jumping Derby, but the Foxfield Jumping Derby will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. The event, its directors and employees, and the officials and employees of the Foxfield Jumping Derby shall be blameless for any loss or accident to horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.
6. All owners and exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly.
7. Protests shall be made in writing and delivered to the show secretary accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which will be refunded if the protest is upheld and forfeited if not.
8. **Entries close September 22, 2008.**
9. No refunds without Vet Certificate from closing date to October 1, 2008. \$50.00 office fee on all refunds. After October 1, 2008, no refunds will be issued.
10. After closing date, a post entry fee of \$50.00 per horse will be accepted upon approval of management if paid by noon, October 1, 2008, for the Foxfield and Calabasas Saddlery Jumping Derby.
11. Horses may cross enter in both classes.
12. Foxfield Riding School is closed to all schooling two weeks prior to the Foxfield Jumping Derby. Schooling during the competition will be permitted only in the designated Schooling Area. Schooling jumps must be jumped in the direction in which they are flagged (red flag on right).
13. POLING is illegal in the State of California.
14. The order of go for each class will be drawn separately by competitors when they pick up their numbers at the Horse Show Office.
15. All prize money will be made payable to the owner listed on the entry blank and mailed within thirty days after the show. Prize money will not be mailed unless the owner's social security number is listed on the entry blank. Anyone requesting 1099 changes after the checks have been mailed will be charged \$100 to be paid in advance.
16. Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following manner: \$20.00 will be assessed for each returned check. Accounts must be paid in full in cash or cash equivalent within 10 days or they will be turned into the USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
17. NO DOGS ALLOWED. Any exhibitors, owners or spectators with dogs will be asked to leave.
18. There will be food and beverage available on the grounds.
19. No parking on main grounds without a Preferred Parking Pass.
20. All jumper areas are sand. Warm-up Ring (~100' X 200'), Main Ring (~100 X 200'), Cross Country Field (~400' X 600').
21. Limited stalls are available for \$125.00 each. Stall requests must be included on the entry form. Portable stalls are of canvas construction, 9'6" X 9'6" with doors. Bedding is included.
22. No arrivals before Friday, October 3, 2008. The facilities at Foxfield are closed to any schooling whatsoever.
23. A luncheon honoring the Foxfield Medal Finalists will take place on Saturday, October 4th, poolside at the Postels' home. Each finalist will be given a complimentary luncheon ticket. Additional tickets are available at \$20.00 each and can be ordered on the entry form.
24. A complimentary buffet luncheon for exhibitors and trainers participating in the Foxfield and the Calabasas Saddlery Jumping Derbies will take place on Sunday, October 5th. Each exhibitor and trainer will be given one luncheon ticket. Additional tickets will be available for \$15.00 each and can be ordered on the entry form or purchased at the Horse Show Office.
25. Every competitor in the Foxfield and Calabasas Saddlery Jumping Derbies must declare that he/she possesses the standard of competence necessary and is physically fit for events of this type to which this entry relates. No riders under the age of 12 will be allowed to participate.
