ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

- **Arrival:** Sunday between 2-3 pm.
- **Camp Horse Show:** 3-6 pm on the last day of camp.
- **Departure:** After the awards ceremony and spaghetti dinner following the camp show (about 7:30 pm).
(Note: Campers going to Burbank Airport with Foxfield stay over until the following morning.)
- **Session 3 additional horse shows:** SumFun – Saturday afternoon; Foxfield Summer (rated) - Saturday & Sunday
(Prize lists will be mailed prior to the shows; participation is optional.)

Resident Summer Camp General Information

- *When to apply...*Because enrollment is limited, we suggest making application as soon as possible. Previous students have preference, but must have applications in by the end of January.
- *How are campers placed in groups...*Campers are placed in cabins by age, in lessons by ability.
- *Cabins...*Each air-conditioned cabin sleeps 6 girls in bunk beds plus a counselor and has its own bath.
- *Laundry...*A laundry service picks up clothing twice during each long session (once during Session 5).
- *Entertainment...*TV's and radios are provided in the Club House. Campers may bring radios for their room.
- *Beach Day...*There is a field trip to the beach during Sessions 1-4.
- *Swimming...*There is a swimming pool by the cabins.
- *Medical...*Good physicians and an excellent hospital are within a 15-minute drive of the school.
- *Meals...*Meals are carefully planned to provide a nutritious, well-balanced diet. We must be notified in advance if your child is a vegetarian.
- *Spending money...*The Head Counselor maintains a "bank" for each camper. Please leave **spending money** in small denominations only (dollar bills are best). There are soda machines at Foxfield and a snack bar at the beach, along with a trip to a local tack store for those campers who are interested. The ice cream man also stops here during the summer.
- *Bringing a horse to camp...*Campers may bring their own horses for an additional \$250 per session (\$175 for Session 5). Stalls are limited and are on a first-come basis. Price includes individual box stall and alfalfa hay fed twice per day. Different diet, extra feed or grain must be provided by the camper and brought in covered containers with name and lock. Campers with their own horses must bring a tack box, saddle and bridle. There is a storage room available for the saddle and bridle. Horses must vacate stalls by 10 am the day after camp ends. Every horse must have a health certificate stating that all shots are current.
- *Airport pick-up...*Airport pick-up is available from Burbank Airport only for an additional fee of \$45.00. Please have arrival time between 12 noon and 2 pm on Sunday. Either call the office at 805-495-5515 or email ride@foxfield.com with flight information at least two weeks before session begins.
- *After camp...*If you would like your camper to be taken to Burbank Airport at the end of camp, make reservations between 9-11 am on the morning following the last day of the session. This service is available for an additional fee of \$50.00.
- *Phone calls...*We discourage phone calls, but if you must talk to your camper, please call during meal times (8-9 am, 12 noon – 1 pm, 6-7 pm) because they are out with the horses at other times. Campers are not allowed to bring cell phones to camp. If they do, they will be collected and returned at the end of the session.
- *Email & fax...*We ask that you not visit or take children out at mealtime. Feel free to email your camper at ride@foxfield.com or fax 805-497-1799. Campers do not have access to a computer but messages are printed and distributed when they come in.
- **Mailing instructions...**Campers welcome packages (no chewing gum, please). Since we are in the country and do not get mail delivery from the post office, please send them via carriers such as UPS, Fedex, Airborne, etc. to our street address: 1250 E. Potrero Rd., Lake Sherwood, CA 91361. **Mail cards and letters only to Foxfield, P.O. Box 3576, Westlake Village, CA 91359.**
